### **Tickets Now On Sale for Up-Close Oxnard Salsa Festival Concert Seating/ Leslie Paula & 12-Piece Latin Soul Band Headline July 28 Kick-Off Concert**

Oxnard, CA--For those wanting to experience all the sights, sounds and vibes of great salsa music and dance, tickets are now on sale for up-close main-stage/dance floor concert seating at the 24<sup>th</sup> Annual Oxnard Salsa Festival held July 29 and 30 at [Plaza Park](#), Fifth and "B" streets in historic downtown Oxnard.

Shaded table seating for six can be reserved on the west side of the salsa festival main stage and dance floor. A limited number of individual tickets for shaded table seating are available at "Club Salsa" on the east side of the stage. Individual tickets are \$30 each.

Open seating tickets are \$5 per person (kids under age 10 are free). Festivalgoers can bring their own chairs for lawn seating or can sit in the chairs provided. Seats are not assigned. No lawn umbrellas are allowed. Concert tickets are good for the entire day and those who purchase tickets will receive a wristband for easy in and out access to the seating area. ### **Friday Night Concert**

The salsa celebration starts a day early with a Friday, July 28 concert at Plaza Park. Sponsored by [Shock Top](#), [Leslie Paula](#) and her 12-piece Latin Soul Band with perform with special guest Latin signer Yari More. The concert will be held from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. (gates open at 5:30 p.m.). Joining Paula will be her father, Latin jazz icon percussionist Miguel Gutierrez.

Lawn seating for the Friday night concert is \$15 in advance (\$17 the night of the concert) with table seating for six, \$120. Bring a picnic dinner. Beer and wine margaritas are available for purchase (no outside alcohol is permitted). Parking is in the 4<sup>th</sup> and B Streets garage. Besides live entertainment, festival event highlights include a salsa tasting tent, an eclectic vendor marketplace, international foods, a kids' play zone, community stage and a salsa recipe contest. Festival admission and parking are free. No dogs or coolers are permitted.
